

Private Policy

"BURGOZONE" Ltd, as an administrator and processor of personal data, collects, processes and uses personal data provided by a client only with his explicit consent or when there is a legal requirement for that. Personal data collected, processed and used are in the volume required for the provision of services by BURGOZONE Ltd. and are voluntarily provided by the client for such purposes.

The Customer is entitled, at any time and on grounds relating to his / her particular situation, to object to the processing of personal data relating to him / her, including profiling.

The administrator is under an obligation to discontinue the processing of personal data except in the presence of legitimate processing grounds that take precedence over the interests, rights and freedoms of the data subject or for the establishment, exercise or protection of legal claims.

When processing personal data for direct marketing purposes, Customer may at any time object to the processing of personal data relating to it for this type of marketing, including profiling insofar as it relates to direct marketing.

When a client objects to processing for direct marketing purposes, the processing of personal data for these purposes is terminated by the administrator.

The client has the right not to be subject to a decision based solely on automated processing involving profiling that produces legal consequences for him or her significantly and may require human intervention by the controller, the right to express his or her point of view and to challenge the decision. The same shall not apply where:

- (a) it is necessary for the conclusion or performance of a contract between the client and the administrator;
- (b) is permitted by law;
- (c) is based on the express consent of the customer

The Administrator declares that he is familiar with the text of the General Regulation on Personal Data Protection and adheres to the principles set out therein and to the rights of data subjects.

Definitions

"Personal Data Administrator" is a natural or legal person, public body, agency or other entity which, alone or jointly with others, defines the purposes and means of processing personal data; where the objectives and means for such processing are determined by either EU law or the law of a Member State, the controller or the specific criteria for its determination may be established in EU law or in the law of a Member State.

"Personal data processor" means a natural or legal person, a public authority, an agency or other entity that processes personal data on behalf of the controller.

"Processing of personal data" is any operation or set of operations performed with personal data or a set of personal data by automatic or other means such as collecting, recording, organizing, structuring,

storing, adapting or changing, retrieving, consulting, using, disclosing by transmission, dissemination or other means by which data becomes available, arranged or combined, limited, deleted or destroyed

"Data subject consent" means any free expression, specific, informed and unambiguous indication of the will of the data subject by means of a statement or a clear confirmatory act expressing the consent of the data subject to be processed

"Personal data" means any information relating to an identifiable natural person or a natural person ("data subject"); an identifiable natural person is a person who can be identified, directly or indirectly, in particular by an identifier such as name, identification number, location data, online identifier or one or more signs specific to the physical, physiological, genetic, mental, mental, economic, cultural or social identity of that individual.

"Contractual purposes" means the purposes for the processing of personal data specified in these terms and conditions.

Under these terms and conditions, the personal data controller defines the purposes and means of processing personal data as follows:

Use of personal data in connection with the use of the site and processing of orders and payments

When the customer uses the general information collection website, it is not necessary to enter any personal data. Data collected and used in this connection is limited to data that the client's internet browser automatically transmits, such as web page request date and time, browser type, browser settings, and IP address. This data is collected in a way that does not allow a customer connection and only guarantees the access to the web pages it has selected. The IP address is only stored for the duration of the page visit. No personal data assessment or analysis is performed.

The following personal data are collected: names, age // date of birth, address, email and phone only when necessary to customize the site for the customer and process the order and payments in relation to the online contract service offered . Third party data is transferred only as necessary to meet the obligations of BURGOZONE Ltd. related to service and transportation. Data transferred to third parties is used only for the purposes and performance of tasks that are required to perform under the terms of the agreement. The third person is a subcontractor of "BURGOZONE" Ltd. or a member of its group of companies and processes personal data on its behalf in a secure manner and in accordance with the instructions given to it.

Upon registration, when the customer requests additional information or personally contacts BURGOZONE LTD employees, the administrator and personal data processor may maintain and maintain a record of the correspondence, as well as include the information it contains in its database, which is maintains in accordance with the requirements of the General Data Protection Regulation.

Data storage / data delete information

The customer may update, correct, block or request the deletion of his / her personal data if this does not violate any legal requirement.

The customer may request information about the volume, nature, purpose, and origin of the collected personal data at any time. The requested information is provided free of charge within one month at the address given at the end of this chapter on personal data protection.

Data security

"BURGOZONE" Ltd. applies appropriate technical and organizational measures for the protection of personal data against unauthorized or unlawful processing and against accidental loss, destruction, damage, alteration or disclosure such as technical equipment, including portable equipment, stored in locked areas supervision; no portable equipment containing unattended personal data is left; Administrator staffs use appropriate secure passwords to log in to systems or databases containing personal data; access to relevant databases and systems is limited to employees and subcontractors who must have access to personal data by regularly changing and updating passwords in order to prevent unauthorized access when the persons are no longer engaged by the respective country; conducting a regular risk assessment and / or intrusion testing; staff working with personal data are aware of their responsibilities with regard to the processing of personal data.

n case of suspected violation of the rights related to the administration and processing of personal data by BURGOZONE OOD, the client has the right to refer the personal data protection committee.
